The Pace Broward Executive Director will provide vision, culture, and leadership to the staff while managing resources to ensure the mission, vision, values and principles of Pace are accomplished in the Broward community.

The position will oversee multiple teams comprising a staff of more than 50 goal-oriented committed team members. Experience in social services and/or mental health is beneficial to directing a multifaceted program including academics, counseling, case management, behavioral health, therapy and community advocacy. In addition, experience with fundraising, marketing, special events and/or community relations is extremely helpful.

Working closely with the Development Director, Board of Directors, and team members, the Executive Director will be responsible for managing an annual \$4.2 million budget through the solicitation of major gifts, corporate and foundation support, and special events, while also ensuring the execution of federal and state contracts and grants.

To be considered for this position, candidates must have a minimum of 7-10 years non-profit management experience including resource development. Preferred candidates will have extensive experience in the Tri-County area, with demonstrated experience in community engagement and collaboration.
