About Us

The Everglades Foundation is a 501(c)(3) non-profit dedicated to leading efforts to restore and protect the greater Everglades ecosystem. Since its founding in 1993 by a group of local outdoor enthusiasts, the Foundation has become a respected and important advocate for the sustainability of one of the world's most unique ecosystems. As the leading voice in science-based Everglades restoration,

The Everglades Foundation is a responsible employer that seeks to recruit and retain outstanding, high performing professionals who are at the top of their fields, to thrive in a dynamic, mission-driven culture committed to excellence, innovation, collaboration, and diversity.

Funds raised by the Foundation are used for scientific research, advancing understanding of the Greater Everglades ecosystem, advocating for key restoration and preservation projects, and providing grants to conservation partners. In addition, The Foundation supports necessary legal actions to help protect the Everglades. Through environmental leadership, scientific expertise, and policy experience, the Everglades Foundation works to protect and restore America's Everglades.

The Foundation's world-class science department conducts and sponsors scientific research and analysis so that its policies, positions, and actions are governed by facts. The Foundation has an operating budget of \$10+ million, a talented staff of 34, and a high-profile national 35-member Board of Directors. The Foundation's Board has committed to personally support the organization's administrative and fundraising costs to allow all support raised from outside donors to go directly toward work in science, research, education, and advocacy.

Position Summary

The Director of Development for Broward County will be an individual with a strong knowledge of philanthropy and documented success in stewarding major donors and securing major gifts of \$10,000 and above. The ideal candidate possesses versatile development expertise, cares deeply about philanthropy, has worked with knowledgeable and sophisticated donors and Boards of Directors, and has a passion and enthusiasm for the Everglades. The Director of Development will be responsible for planning, organizing,

and directing fundraising, stewardship, and donor acquisition activities in Broward County and the surrounding areas.

Reporting to the Vice President of Development and collaborating closely with the Executive Leadership Team and Board of Directors (particularly directors in Broward County), the Director of Development takes initiative and actively seeks to deepen current donor relationships and to forge new ones. The Director will execute a comprehensive development strategy to acquire new donors and sustain the current major donor base for The Everglades Foundation in Broward County and the surrounding areas. The Director will plan and implement ongoing fundraising efforts and activities, including Everglades briefings, tours, and fundraising events. In the era of COVID-19, the Foundation looks for a self-directed individual who will utilize creative thinking and innovative strategies moving forward, and is comfortable in a remote work environment.

Primary Responsibilities

The Director of Development, Broward County, reports to the Vice President of Development and has the following responsibilities:

Fundraising Goals

Operate with annual fundraising goals for total dollars raised and acquisition of new donors, with

accountability for annual results.

Fundraising Strategy

Collaborate with the Vice President of Development and the Development Team to identify strategies for donor acquisition, solicitation, and retention, with particular focus on Broward County communities. Develop and maintain key long-term relationships with donors and prospects, including a personal pool of major gift prospects to cultivate, solicit, and steward. Conduct research, prospecting, and application to multiple donor sources, and work to incorporate annual giving strategies and tactics to advance donors toward major giving.

Outreach, Education, and Events

Plan, organize, manage, and assess events and activities, such as tours, receptions, briefings,

meetings, benefits, and other events in the Broward County region. Be willing and able to provide effective and engaging educational Everglades briefings, tours, and presentations as part of development efforts. In light of changing environment and practices due to COVID-19, it is essential that the Foundation and the Director are responsive to individual donors and groups of donors, and are able to provide opportunities to support the organization in non-traditional means.

Communications & Follow-up

Collaborate and communicate effectively and efficiently with the Executive Leadership Team, other members of the Development Team, the Communications Team, and Program Directors. Write and provide personal, proactive, timely responses and relevant updates on programs, initiatives, and activities of the Foundation.

- o Thorough understanding of and ability to participate in all aspects of the gift cycle that includes generating prospect leads, initiating contacts with current and prospective donors, developing appropriate cultivation "moves management" strategies that at times involve working with volunteers and board members, moving potential donors in an appropriate and timely fashion toward solicitation, personally making solicitations, and maintaining stewardship contacts with donors
- § Experience with and thorough knowledge of Raiser's Edge database a plus
- § Demonstrable experience planning, leading, and managing development projects, including coordinating with peers to achieve desired outcomes and tracking and reporting on progress to senior leadership and Board of Directors
- § Demonstrable experience in achieving fundraising goals
- § Commitment to the educational mission of the Everglades Foundation and ability to

communicate it confidently and persuasively

- § Ability to see and understand objectives of the overall fundraising program and to integrate personal goals with overall strategic objectives of the Foundation

- § A passion and enthusiasm for the Everglades and/or the environment a plus
- § An optimistic outlook and enthusiastic attitude

- § Ability to be flexible and work under deadlines and time constraints
- § Ability to thrive in a high-energy, fast-paced work environment as part of a team of ambitious, high-functioning, goal-oriented professionals

- § Ability to proactively solve problems and think analytically
