- Communicate to Facilities and Technologies Manager any needs related to adequate inventory, ordering and use of maintenance and repair supplies.

- Proven skills in cleaning or maintenance
- Attention to detail
- Ability to operate mechanical cleaning equipment, including vacuum, carpet cleaner and grounds maintenance equipment
- Ability to lift 40 pounds
- Ability to walk stairs
- Ability to stand, walk and move for hours at a time
- Energetic and willing to work flexible shifts and split shifts, including early mornings, nights or weekends
